CHIRP & DRIFT, KATHY HINDE A light and sound sculpture featuring a 'flock' of illuminated instruments shaped like birds that chatter in morse code messages. Gentle tones and harmonies are made by accordion reeds hidden within each bird in this magical installation.



CIRCLE OF LIGHT, TOY STUDIO Bathe in a rainbow of colours in Queen Square and walk through each colour to see the city in a different light. This installation is beautiful both day and night.

THE EYES. DESIGNS IN AIR The trees have been watching us and the city evolve for years, what do you think they have seen?



SWING SONG, TIRED INDUSTRIES College Green becomes a playground with six swings which light up and play music in sync to your swings. Fly high for a crescendo, or go low for more ambient vibes. A collaboration between Jon Panniers, Tim Harrison & Owen Davis.



OVERHEARD IN BRISTOL. **BRISTOL LIGHT FESTIVAL** Overheard in Bristol is back this great Bristolian phrase "Alright my & Coach Station.



DISCO BALL, **BRISTOL LIGHT FESTIVAL** Follow the call of the Disco Ball - A giant disco ball has appeared on Millennium Square bringing with it a ton of glitter, sparkles and disco dance beats. Come along and bring your best disco moves.



A giant slinky lights up Cascade Steps. Each coil of the oversized spring is illuminated in turn to create the familiar flowing form of a slinky tumbling end-over-end.



SIGN NIGHT - HAND SHIPS SAIL, CATHY MAGER Two deaf women separated by lockdown unite through sign language in a poetic projection, originally commissioned as a short film for the BBC, newly adapted for Bristol Light Festival.

LUMINOUS BIRDS. KATHY HINDE An animated flock of origami-style birds will fly overhead in Temple Gardens. As night falls, synchronised sequences of music and light create the effect of the birds flying overhead.



OFFICE PARTY. PARKER HEYL & MICHAEL WAGNER Exploring the playful idea that our workspaces may come to life in our absence, Office Party is a kinetic installation bringing unexpected liveliness to the windows of Cheese Lane Shot Tower.



FUTURES, LUCID CREATES The installation uses the optical illusions created by light, sound and mirrors. It features an ambient soundscape by Canadian artists "Exist Strategy".



EXPONENTIAL, LUCID CREATES Exponential is a seemingly-floating, kaleidoscopic mirrored cube, encased in endlessly moving patterns of light, accompanied by an ambient soundtrack.
