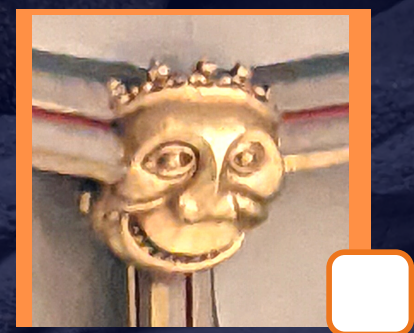
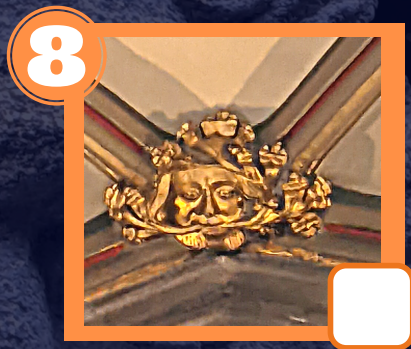


Did you spot the Unicorn

dragons nearby!

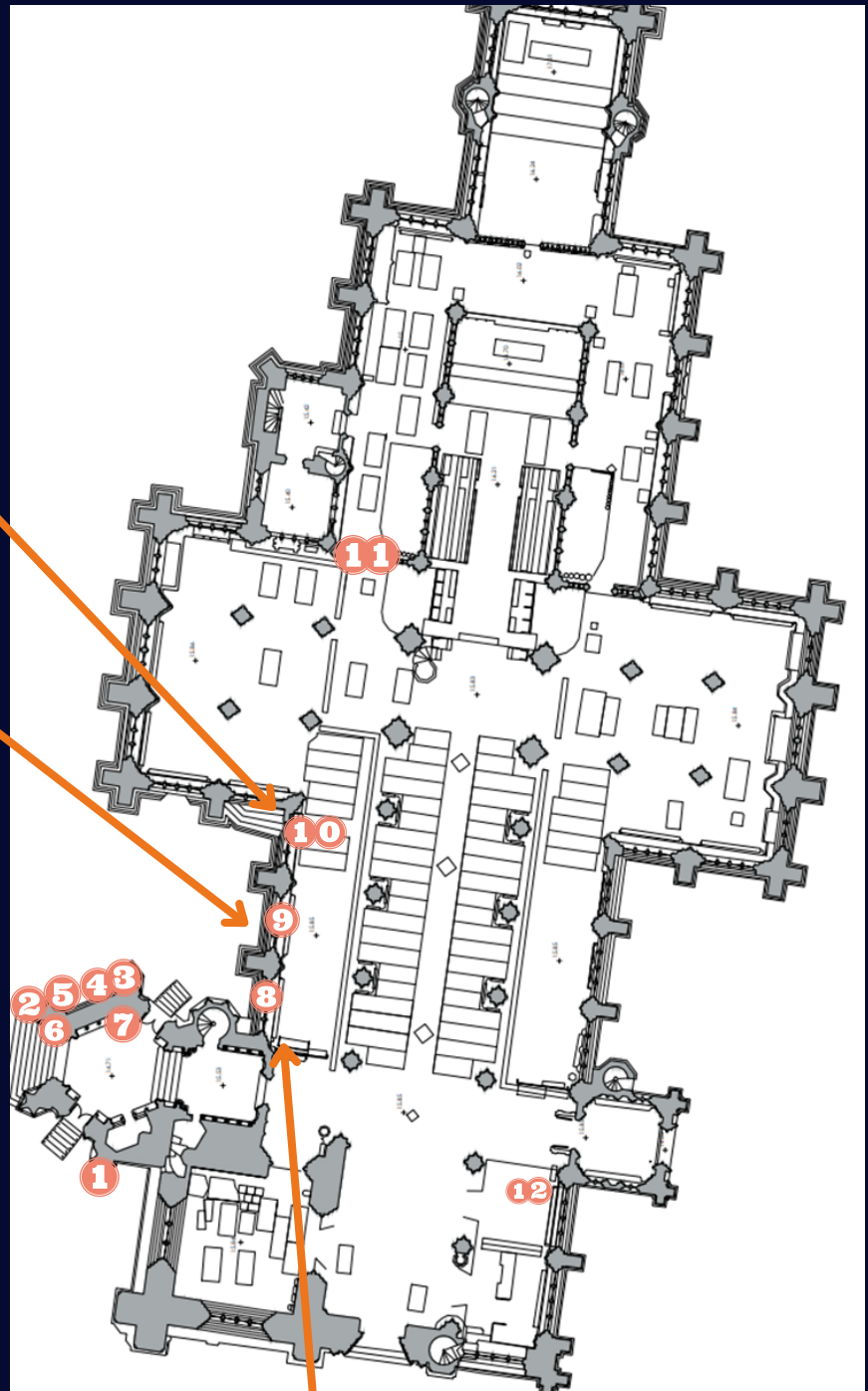
The North Porch
